As a weekday provider of adult day services, Curative Connections offers 11 person-centered programs for approximately 1,600 community members each week. We provide comprehensive support for individuals with dementia, brain injury, stroke, or other cognitive conditions. Additionally, Curative Connections offers work, life, and social skills development along with specialized transportation services for people with disabilities and our aging population.

What We Do

Early Memory Loss & Dementia

Early Memory Loss & Dementia Programs are designed for those who are experiencing memory loss and confusion or who are diagnosed with any type of dementia or other neurological conditions. Our programs feature different group environments tailored to support individuals at different stages of disease progression. Note: though programs are designed for individuals with dementia, program enrollment is not dependent on an official diagnosis.

Cognitive Rehab & Wellness

Cognitive Rehab & Wellness Programs support individuals with neurological impairments from a traumatic or non-traumatic brain injury, as well as those who may have a diagnosis of autism, down syndrome, or cerebral palsy. Length of members stay depends on the goals that are set as well as skills and compensatory strategies attained.

Social Rec & Enrichment (Adult Day)

Social Rec and Enrichment Programs offer a fun, supportive, and safe space for adults with disabilities and aging concerns to spend the day. Led by skilled staff, both programs provide a supervised environment where caregivers can feel comfortable leaving their loved ones for the day. Our staff is equipped to handle personal cares and we have nurses available to provide support. Locations in Green Bay and Shawano.

Work, Life, & Social Skills Training

Our skill-building programs support adults with disabilities in achieving their goals at home, work, and in the community. Employment and training services develop job skills and guide career exploration, while life skills activities promote independence through fun, person-centered experiences and outings.

Specialized Transportation Services 920-227-4272

Provides a door-to-door transportation service within Brown County to adults 60 years and older and people with disabilities, allowing them to lead a more fulfilling, and self-sufficient lifestyle. Rides are provided to doctor appointments, jobs, grocery stores, social outings, and more. A large vehicle fleet includes cars and accessible vans/ buses to accommodate various mobility levels.
