Early Memory Loss & Dementia programs are designed for those who are experiencing memory loss and confusion or who are diagnosed with any type of dementia or other neurological condition. Note: though programs are designed for individuals with dementia, program enrollment is not dependent on an official diagnosis.

Dementia Day Programs

Dementia program options include: Small Group Care, Large Group Care, and Reminiscent Care. The overall program structure is similar but all programs provide a combination of group and individualized activities. Nurses are available to support program staff daily. Participants can enjoy a wide variety of fun and engaging options throughout the day, including games, creative projects, entertainment, guest speakers, food demonstrations, and therapy animals.
